## How to Create a Welcome Kit

- 1. If donating more than 5 Kits, contact HWR to inquire which Kit is most urgent.
- 2. All of the Kits (except the Kid's Kit and bedding) need to be packaged in a CLEAR plastic bin with lid. Oversized items (indicated by an asterisk) can be included separately.
- Label the lid and short sides of the container with the Welcome Kit name (tape or paper). Please do not tape the tub closed.
- 4. Please purchase NEW items only. Tape the top of all liquid bottles so they do not spill.
- 5. We encourage you to include a hand-written, unsealed note welcoming the family.
- 6. Drop off the Kits & items on a Collection Day. Please check the calendar on our website for dates and times of upcoming Collection Days.
